Fellowship in Clinical Optometry (Year - 2019)



FELLOWSHIP in CLINICAL OPTOMETRY

Important Dates:

- Program Duration: 13 months for Graduate Optometrist & 24 months for Diploma holder Optometrist
 - Entrance Test Date: **15th June, 2019**
 - Last date for Application Form: 10th June, 2019
 - Program Commencing Date: **1st July, 2019**

Goals and Fellow Responsibilities:

The FELLOWSHIP program will be a thirteen/ twenty-four months program, and the minimum amount of time to be devoted to clinical work will be 6 days per week. This clinical work will consist primarily of clinical posting with optometrists / ophthalmologists and independent patient care. Teaching and other requirements will fill the remainder of the week.

- To do emergency duties on Sunday and night emergency duties according to roster.

Characteristics of the Program:

- a) The fellow will prepare and present lectures/Journal articles/case reports in morning classes.
- b) The fellow also will be involved in maintaining of the logbook of the activities done during the program period. The fellow will submit the filled logbook at the end of the 6th month and end of the 12th month to the respective advisor for comments.
- c) The fellow will also submit one interesting case report to the advisor/mentor every month.
- d) The fellow have to submit one project at the end of FELLOWSHIP.
- e) At the end of the program the fellow would have either observed and/or independently handled at least 300 clinical cases.

List of the Topics Covered in Program:

- 1st month of fellowship dedicated for theory classes on basics of optometric work up.
- From 2nd to 7th month of fellowship, rotation posting in different Clinics according to duty roster.
- From 8th month onwards Speciality posting (Anterior Segment, Posterior Segment and Pediatrics etc.) will be assigned.
- At the end of first month theoretical classes examination will be conducted to assess the learning of new admitted fellows.
- Fellows with very poor performance would be asked to leave fellowship program.
- The candidates will be posted in the charitable wing of the hospital and has to attend the community outreach programs and vision screening camps in schools and colleges

Eligibility:

- The candidate should have completed either their 4 or 2 years of optometry education (without any backlog/courses) from a recognized optometry school/college/institute.
- All fellow must undergo a basic written exam and clinical skills assessment which includes objective refraction, subjective refraction and assessment of ocular health.

Stipend:

- Fellows completed 4 years Bachelor degree will be paid a monthly stipend of Rs.6000/- month.
- Fellows with 2 years Diploma degree will not paid any stipend in first 12 months of and will be eligible to get Rs.6000/- stipend month in last 12 months of fellowship.
